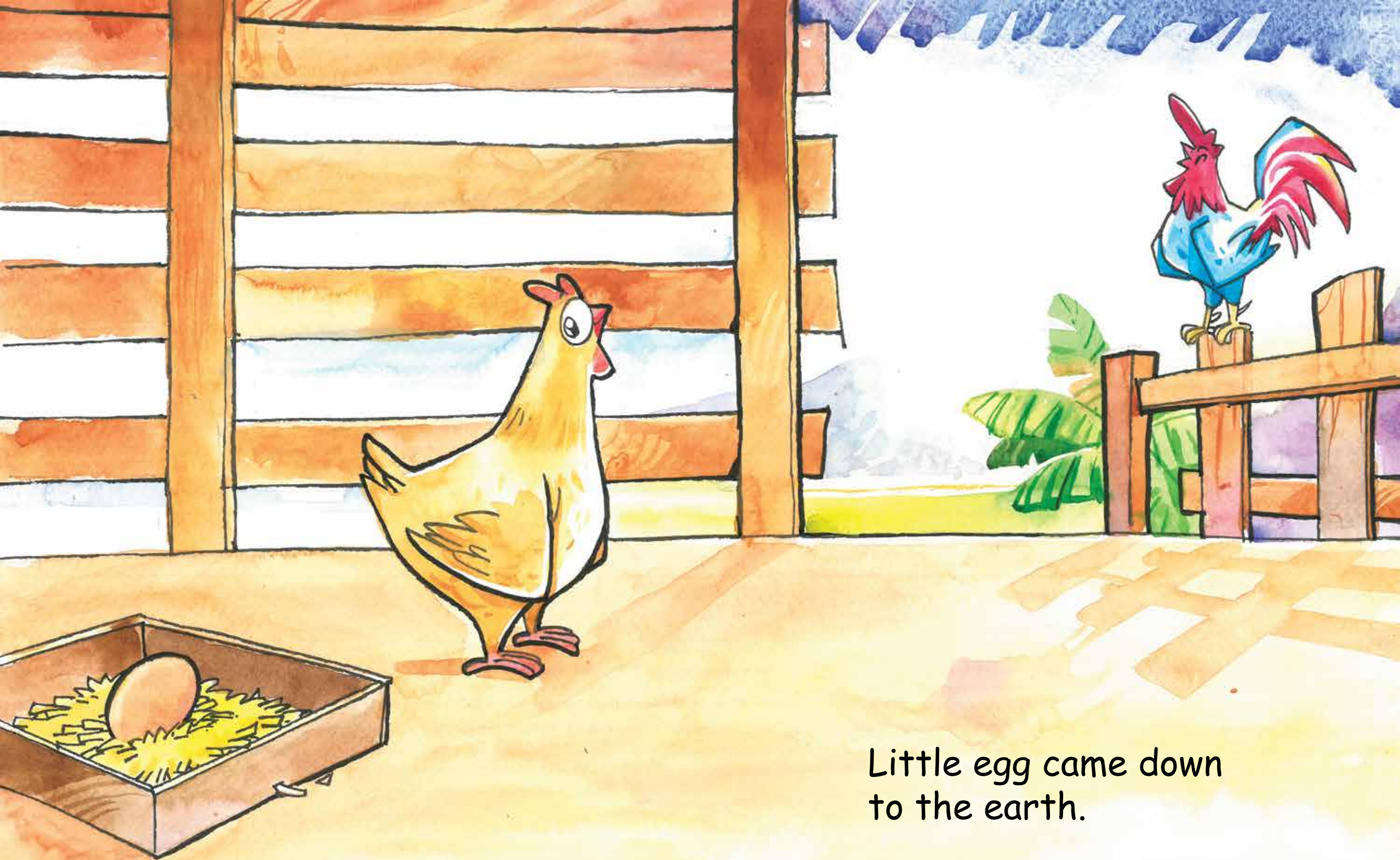

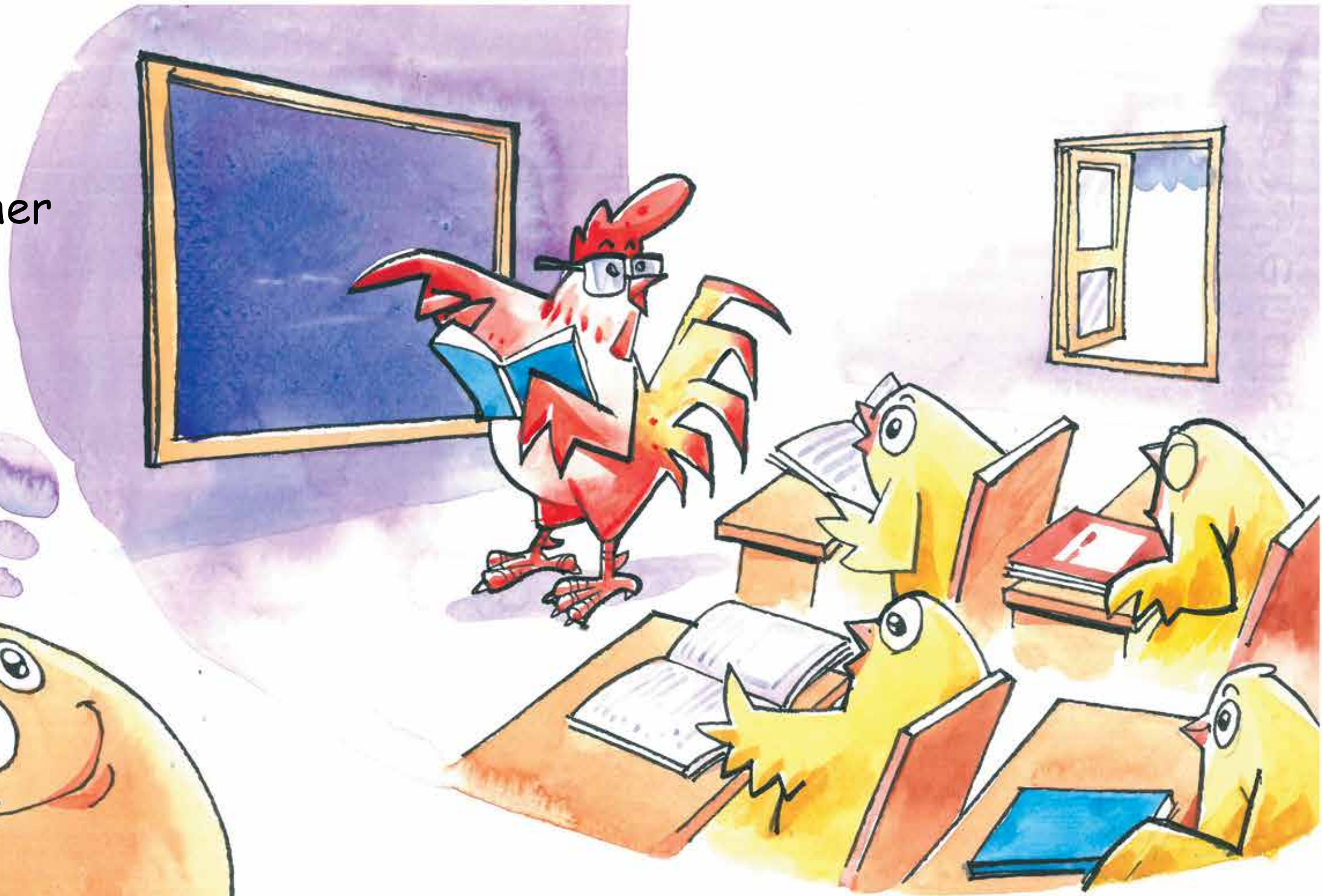
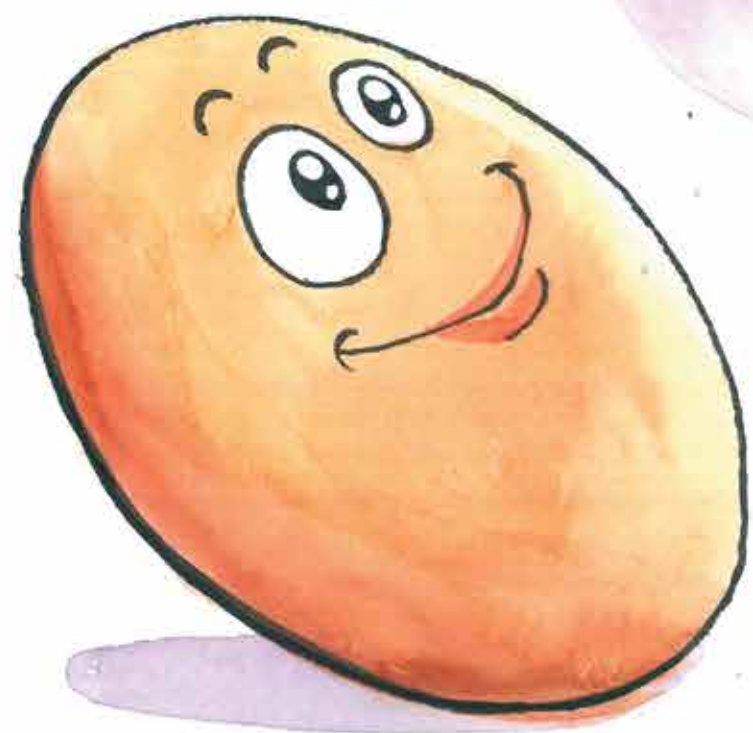


Father Rooster and Mother Hen loved him and his brothers and sisters very much.

scared.



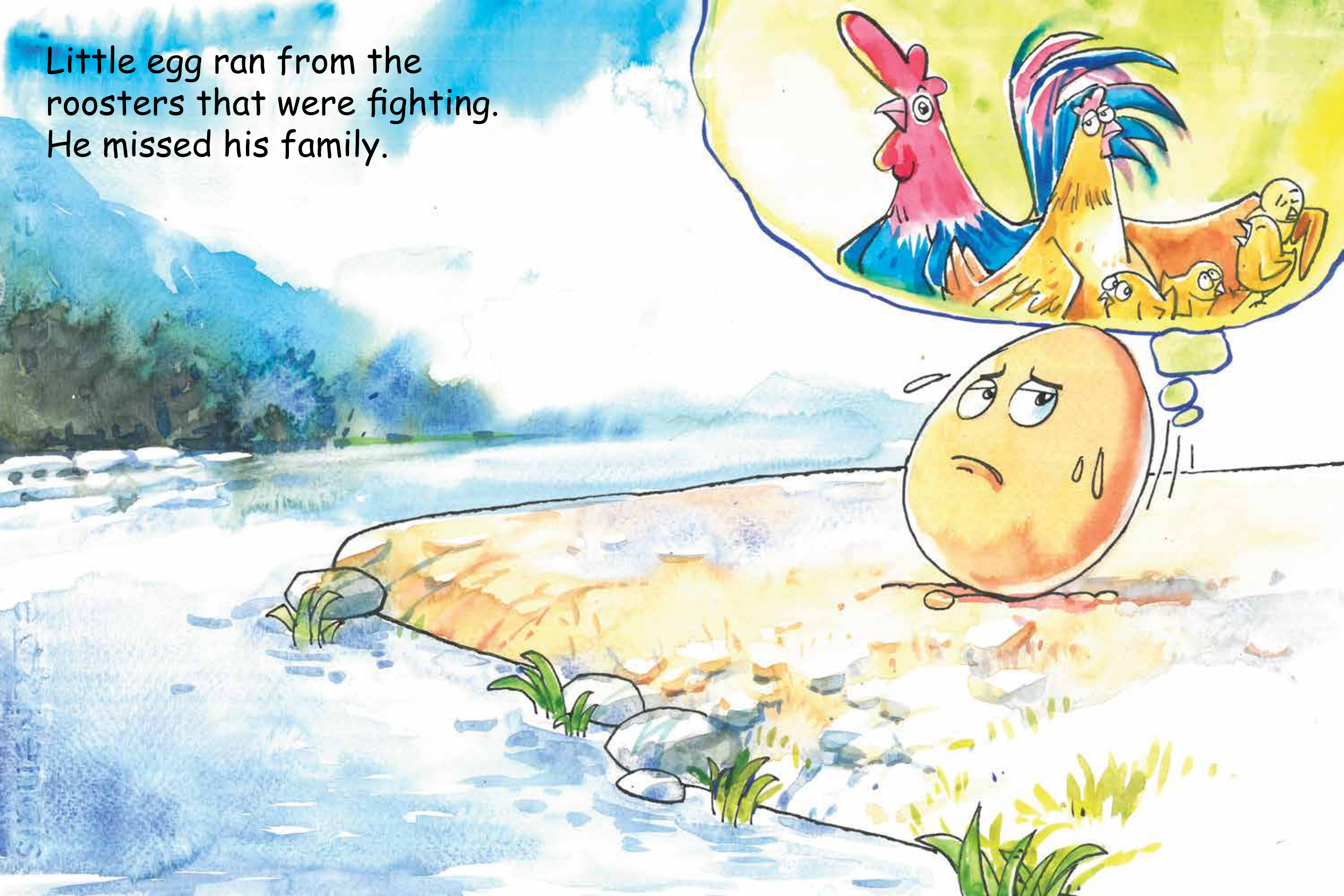


Little egg cried for his mother and father. He couldn't find them or his brothers and sisters.



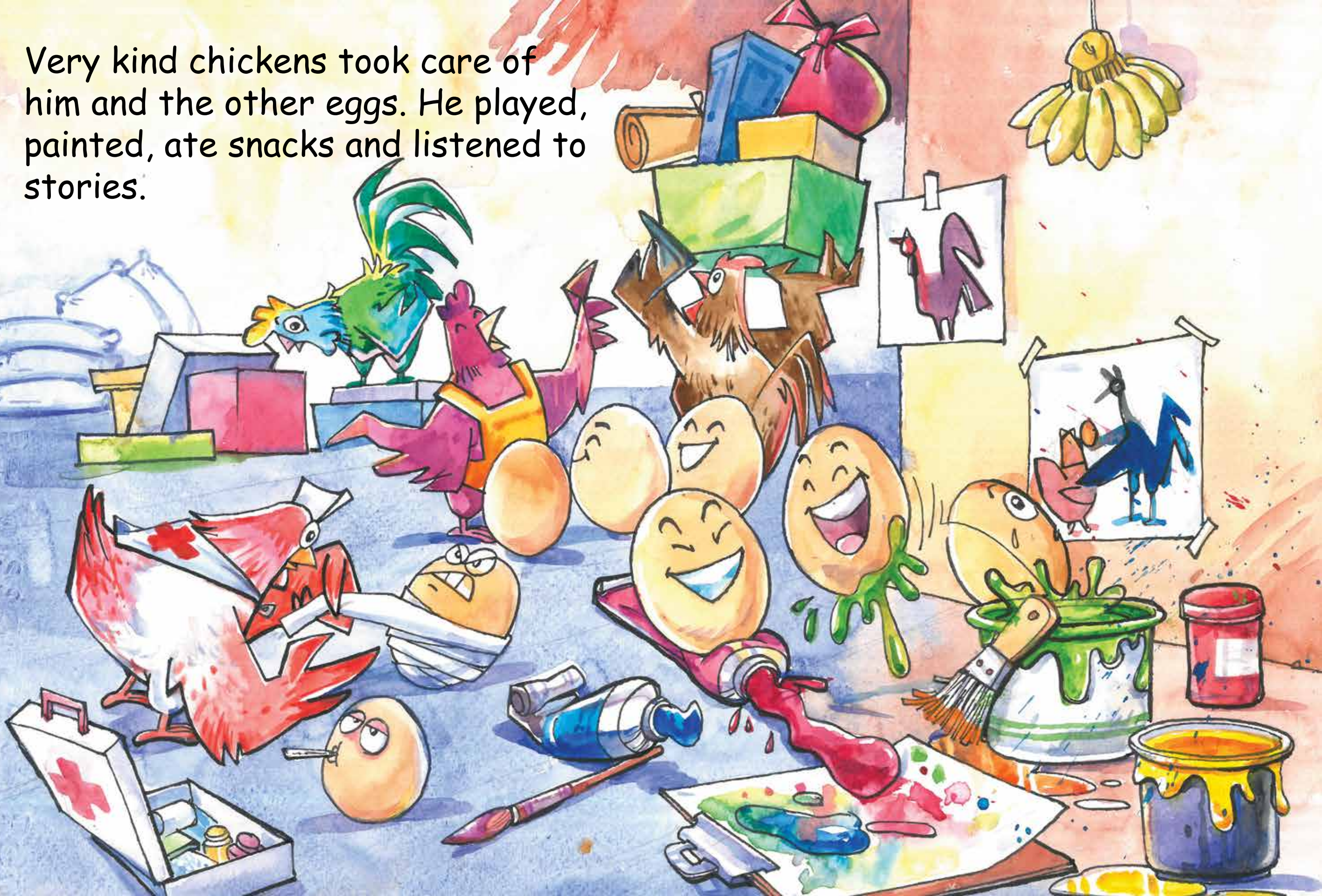


Little egg ran from the roosters that were fighting. He missed his family.





Very kind chickens took care of him and the other eggs. He played, painted, ate snacks and listened to stories.



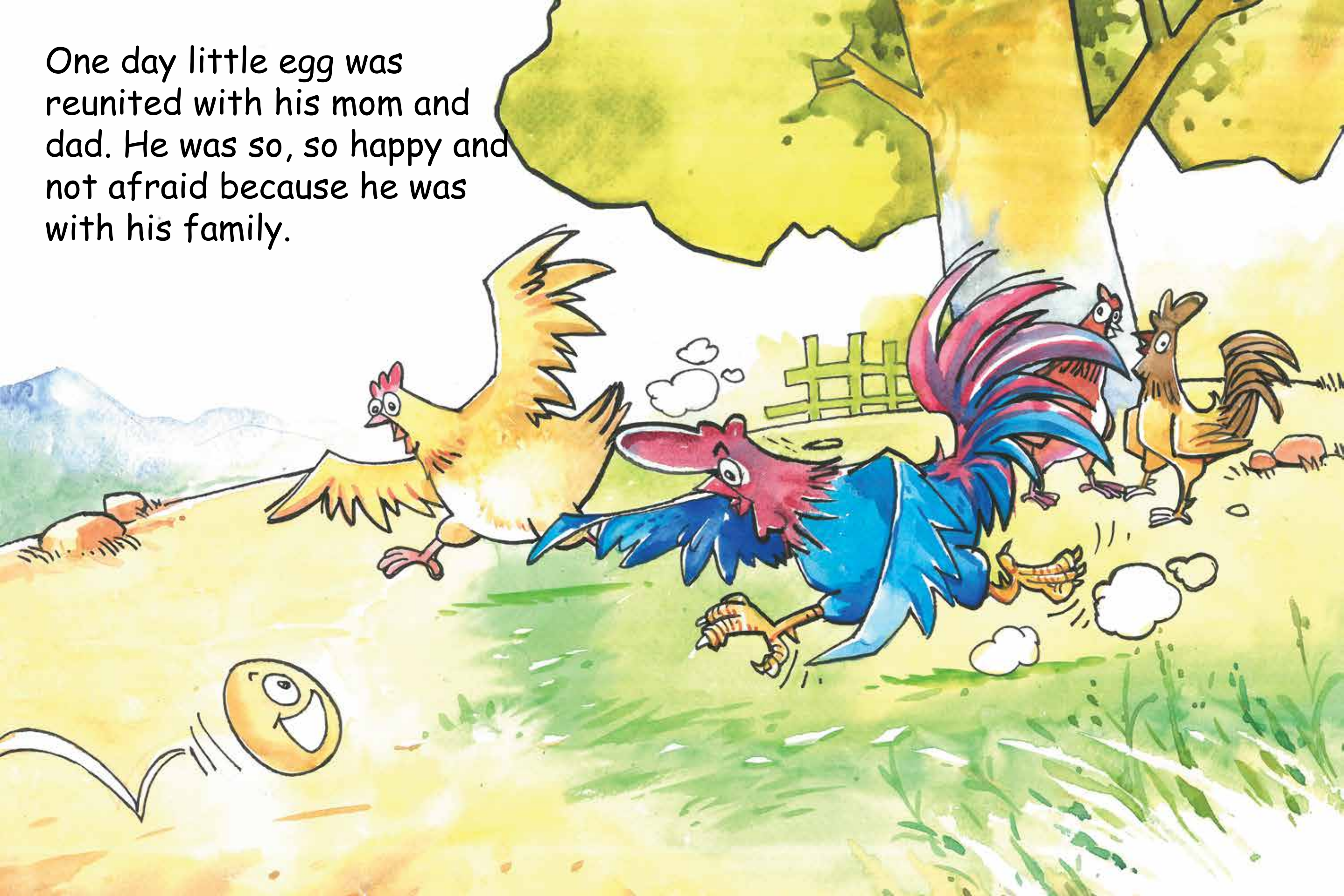




Little egg missed his parents very much. If roosters didn't fight he could live with them.

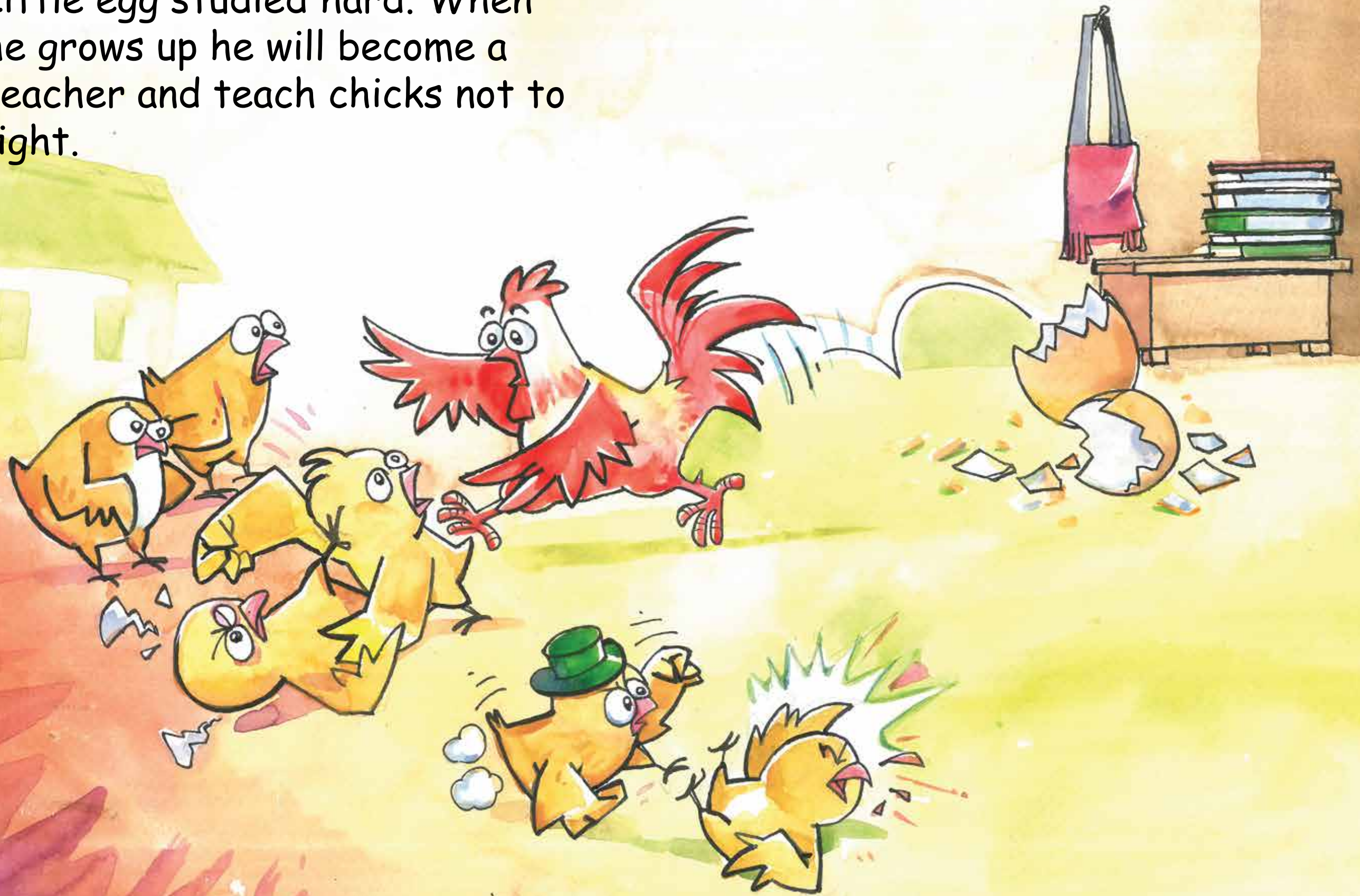


One day little egg was reunited with his mom and dad. He was so, so happy and not afraid because he was with his family.
