Good morning, everyone!




The bus rides along. I see a building with square panels. Where am I now?




Oh, it's that big aquarium! I am going the right way, then.

Whew! I can't see the giant anymore.






Oh, I know this shop! There's the cat that sells donuts. I am going the right way, then.
